







1. Ma - ry be - held Him, and “Mas - ter!” cried, Af - ter He came from the tomb;

3. Thom - as be - held Him there in the room, Called Him his Mas - ter and Lord,




Sud - den - ly Je - sus stood in their midst, En - tered the tight shut room.
