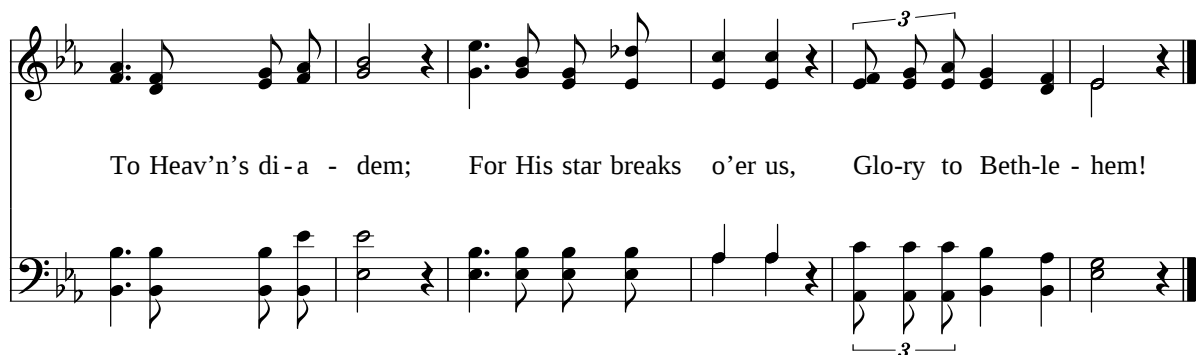


Winds blow fierce and wild! See! a star breaks o'er us, Shines a lust - rous gem;
