4. In the end of time He'll say, "Come, ye reap - ers of the day,

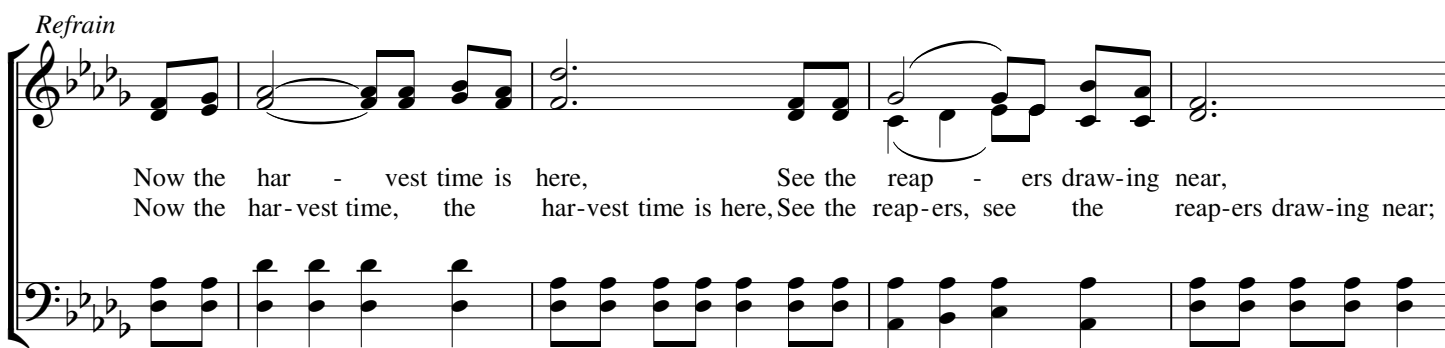


For the reap - ers flam - ing sic - kle read - y stand; See the wav - ing gold - en grain,
