Parts for Brass Quartet/Quintet (Trumpets in  $B_{\flat}$ , Horn in F, and Trombones) and Timpani (G, A, C, D) are included. This piece may be performed with two trumpets and two trombones by playing cue-size notes where present. If a quintet is used, ignore cue-size notes.

Although this piece was originally conceived to be used with the text "We Know That Christ Is Raised", it will be equally effective with the texts "When in Our Music God Is Glorified" and "All Praise to Thee, for Thou, O King Divine". If used with one of these alternate texts, it will be necessary to repeat one of the settings to accommodate the different number of stanzas. The organ harmonizations are by Charles V. Stanford.

The choir and congregation sing from the hymnal. No separate choir or congregation pages are included.
