Performance notes

This is an arrangement of the "Inflammatus et accensus" from the *Stabat Mater*. The original is a minor third higher.

The C Instruments may be flutes (one octave higher), violins, or other appropriate instruments. If performed without the instruments, the keyboard player must substitute the C instrument parts for the right hand part in measures 1–14 and from the second half of measure 49 through measure 53. The remaining instrumental parts are readily adaptable into the right hand keyboard part.

The vocal parts may be perfromed by two equal forces or by a large group and a small group. The dynamic markings are editorial and reflect the practice of performing a repeated passage of music as an "echo." Those dynamic markings in parentheses are to be observed if a small group is singing the second vocal part.
