Each medley may be performed in its entirety, or (if time constraints dictate) presented in an abbreviated format as indicated in the score. A limited print license is granted to the initial purchaser for the local duplication of the solo handbell parts.

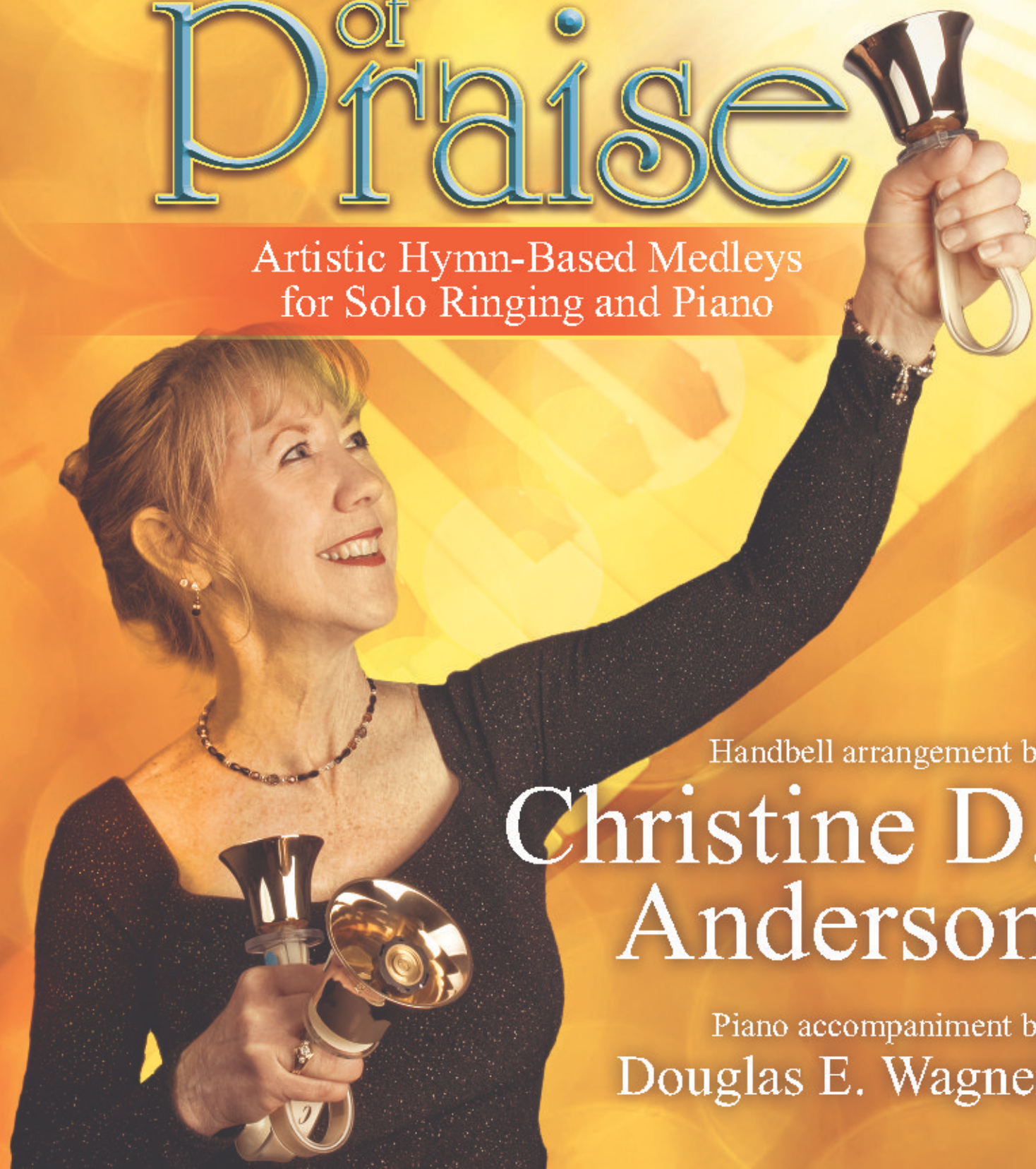
