Six or More for Lent and Easter, is a collection of music specifically scored for those times when a full complement of ringers is not available, or when a few ringers are up to the challenge of ensemble ringing. Of course, as the title implies, the selections contained herein will also work well with the normal number of three octave players. Most titles will also be effective when rung with handchimes.

When using the ensemble assignments as indicated in the Bells Used chart, ringers may experience the need for occasional 'bell sharing'. This should not happen often, but ringers need to be aware of this fact.


It is my hope that ringers will enjoy preparing this music, while embracing the experience as yet another vehicle for uniting all in worship.


