\*Except where indicated, the use of the sostenuto pedal throughout all of the music in this collection, whether performed by the primo or secondo player, should be judiciously and harmonically realized. The slower, sweeping arrangements might employ a more active pedal than some of the other settings that are decidedly staccato and drier in nature. Taste and timbre should prevail.
