The Introduction is a short instrumental piece. It features a Trumpet in C part and an Organ part. The music is in a key with three flats (B-flat major or D-flat minor) and a 4/4 time signature. The organ part includes a 'Ped.' (pedal) marking. The piece begins with a forte (*f*) dynamic and consists of several measures of music, including some rests and a final measure with a whole note.
