This work by Geonyong Lee was first published in the Asian Institute for Liturgy and Music (AILM) *Collection of Asian Church Music, no. 3* in 1985 as a responsorial song between the cantor and the congregation. By 1990 it found its way into the hymnal *Sound the Bamboo* (GIA Publications, Inc., G-6830), where it appeared with a singable English paraphrase by Ronald Hines. Geonyong Lee provided the transliteration of the original Korean, making it possible to sing the piece entirely in Korean, entirely in English, or in a combination of the two. You may wish to sing the ostinato phrases in Korean, while singing the non-repeated text in English. This is an energetic piece and it is vital to avoid an overly slow tempo in presenting it.
