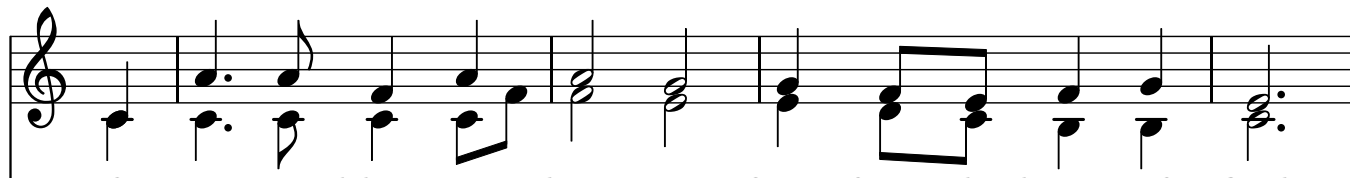




1. There is a place of qui-et rest, Near to the heart of God;
