 That the world God's match - less love might know.



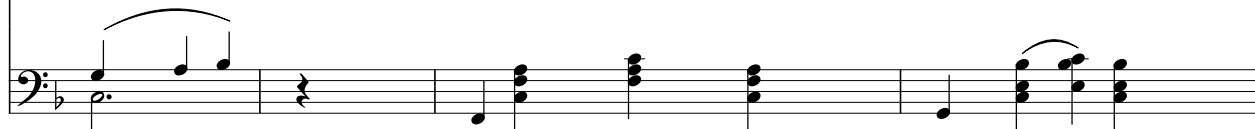
