2 CORINTHIANS 4:6



5. Praise the Lord, there's *glad-ness* in my hap - py soul to-day, Oh, what pleas - ure I have found!




Christ, the Light, is shin - ing in my heart and on the way, I shall rise to glo - ry soon.
